CraftSessionID	Session	End of Session	Created by the Content Management System (CMS) to determine if a user is logged
CRAFT_CSRF_TOKEN	Session	End of Session	Created by the Content Management System (CMS) and used as protection against Cross-Site Request Forgery attacks (CSRF), where form submissions can be hijacked
__utma	Persistent	Expires after two years. However, if a visitor comes back to our website, the cookie will be refreshed, and the countdown will start	As part of the Google Analytics bundle. Used to track each unique visitor to our website by assigning a unique Client ID
__utmb	Session	Expires at the end of 30 minutes of inactivity on the site. If you go to a new page, then it will be refreshed, and the 30 minutes countdown will start over.	As part of the Google Analytics bundle. Keeps track of timeouts and the number of page views your website gets. It also records the start time of each visit.
__utmc	Session	End of Browser session	As part of the Google Analytics bundle. Keeps track of website sessions. As soon as a visit ends, and the browser closes, it records this as one session.
__utmz	Persistent	6 Months	As part of the Google Analytics bundle. Gives us insights into each traffic source. This means that it tracks where each of our visitors are coming from
_ga	Persistent	2 years	Used to identify unique users
_gid	Persistent	1 minute	Used to throttle the request rate
_gat	Persistent	24 hours	Used to distinguish users.
